



Portarlington East of Point Richards

- climate coastal risk overview

There are 16 medium or highly rated risks in this location, 11 are rated high in 2100.

The Bellarine Bayside Caravan Park is a key risk in this location.

Only three are rated as high in 2030. These three risks occur under the 0.8 m SLR scenario and relate to

caravan park buildings and roads and roads outside the caravan park.

There is only one environmental risk for this location, and no risk to private property except for the risk to the proposed development in Portarlington.

The medium (yellow) and high (orange) risks that have been identified for this location are listed in the table below. Where risks are duplicates at the different SLR scenarios, the highest rated risk is included and other SLR scenarios noted.
